Miracle Child Survives Two Brushes With Death

Parents Say Doctors, Prayers Saved Their Son

WEST PALM BEACH, Fla. -- A 5-year-old boy who woke up from his coma is home today after two brushes with death.

Doctors at St. Mary's Medical Center said the possibility was slim for Jack Budensiek to wake up from his coma after a heavy piece of furniture he was climbing fell over and crushed his skull between it and the tile floor. As if that wasn't a serious enough injury, during recovery, Jack was rushed into emergency surgery to remove a blood clot from his brain.

"God choose to save Jack's life twice," said the boy's father, John Budensiek. "If it weren't for God, we wouldn't be walking out of here."

Budensiek was released from the hospital Monday afternoon. His family called it a miracle.

"We are so ecstatic," said his mother, Ada Budensiek. "I could hardly sleep last night."

Thousands of friends are following Jack's story on Facebook. His mother and father are crediting his doctor and prayers from friends and strangers for his recovery.
